OFrontalis Muscle






Test: Raise the eyebrows, wrinkling the forehead, as in an expression of surprise or fright.


OCorrugator Muscle






Test: Draw the eyebrows together, as in frowning.

OProcerus Muscle






Test: Pull the skin of the nose upward, forming transverse wrinkles over the bridge of the nose.

ONasalis Muscle (alar portion)






Test: Widen the apertures of the nostrils, as in forced or difficult breathing.

ONasalis Muscle (Transverse Portion)






Test: Draw the point of the nose downward, narrowing the nostrils.

Orbicularis Occuli Muscle






Test, orbital Part: Close the eyelid firmly forming wrinkles that radiate from outer angle. Palpebral Part: Close the eyelid gently.

Test: Levator Palpebrae Superioris: Raise the upper eyelid.


ORectus Medialis Occuli and Rectus Lateralis Oculi Muscles

• Test, Left Rectus Medialis and Right Rectus Lateralis:






Right Rectus Medialis and Left Rectus Lateralis




Test: Draw the angle of the mouth backward.

OZygomaticus Major Muscle








Test: Draw the angle of the mouth upward and outward, as in smiling.

Test: Raise and protrude the upper lip, as if to show the upper gums.





Test: Draw the lower lip and angle of the mouth downward and outward, tensing the skin over the neck.











Test: Open the mouth slightly. Protrude the lower jaw, and then move the lower jaw sideways, first toward the right and then toward the left

Temporalis, Masseter, and Pterygoideus Medialis Muscles








Test: Close the jaws, and bite firmly with the mouth slightly open to show that the teeth are being clenched,

OSuprahyoid Muscle



Test: Depress the lower jaw against resistance provided by the examiner. During action of the suprahyoid muscles, the infrahyoid muscles furnish fixation of the hyoid bone.
